ArtWorks at Waring is a long-established summer experience of learning and fun. In the morning, children have the chance to work in depth in one of six "MAJORS": Video, Theater, Visual Arts, Writing, Magic, and Musical Theater. *For kids aged 5-7, we have a half-day program, ArtWorks Junior. In the afternoon, there are elective workshops to choose from: conversational French, basketball, hip-hop dance, jewelry-making, acting, chess, games, and other activities. We end the day with recreation and whole-group activities. On the evening of July 29, there will be a musical theater performance open to all, and on July 30 there will be presentations of what we have created together.

ArtWorks: Majors

Writing—We will learn how to create characters, construct plots, and revise. We will use media, the outdoors, and group games to get our creative juices flowing. Then we will focus on formal techniques: character sketches, the story curve, peer editing. Finally, we will produce a short story, and present part of it in a final reading presentation to family and friends.

Theater—Be part of a theater company, learning theater skills and stagecraft. Put on a play at the end. Last year, students wrote and produced their own script.

Music Theater—ArtWorks continues its Broadway success. Beverly will be alive with the sound of music as we prepare and perform a great musical. Join in and be part of a fun ArtWorks tradition (there is an extra \$25 fee for scripts).

Magic—Learn the fundamentals of magic: Palming, Misdirection, Sleight of Hand, and Presentation. We will use a variety of materials from coins to cards and silk to ropes for both close-up and stage effects (there is a \$25 fee for additional materials that students will keep).

Visual Arts—Try all sorts of media: painting, drawing, sculpture, collage, mask-making. Work on your own and on group projects such as murals and sets for the theater production. Visual Arts Majors are known for their wonderful exhibitions at the end of camp.

Video—Be part of a video team that writes, acts in, films, and edits its own series of video pieces. Prior video experience is not necessary but will be helpful. Limited enrollment.

ArtWorks Junior

A hands-on morning program for ages 5-7, including creative art, science and nature, music, puppetry, and story-telling. Take field trips & investigate the Waring campus.

Recreation

Each day there are two recreation periods, one after lunch, the other after electives. Recreation choices are either "loud" or "quiet." And when it is very hot, we add "wet."

Electives

Children choose two electives for the duration of ArtWorks. Choices will be mailed out in early May.
